Access to web site containing the following materials is not necessarily permitted by policy: Violence, Sexually explicit material, Drug culture, Gambling, Intolerance, Sexism, Racism, Militant, Gross and/or Profane material.

Members/Employees/Guests access to Web Sites via the YMCA's Internet connection is not considered Personal and Private. The YMCA retains the right and does use monitoring software to both monitor and check for inappropriate access. Violating policy can result in denial of access to YMCA computers, Net-Pulse machines and/or other YMCA facility use.

Downloading or bringing in software or the use of Instant Massagers is not permitted. Persons that come under the category of hackers/crackers or anyone found attempting malicious or mischievous damage or access to YMCA information or web site will be dealt with as criminals. The illegal use of copyrighted software and files are not permitted on YMCA equipment.

Behavior Guidelines & Disciplines

The Sherwood YMCA Teen Center provides teens with a safe and fun environment where they can develop healthy relationships with both peers and staff. In order to ensure a positive experience for all who enter the Teen Center, we expect our teens to act respectfully at all times when they are on YMCA property and/or participating in our activities. Teens are to behave in a mature, responsible way encompassing the YMCA core values of respect, responsibility, honesty, and care.

The Sherwood YMCA Teen Center encourages teens to have fun and engage in wide variety of activities. However, there are certain rules that are non-negotiable:

- * Teens will respect the feelings of all Teen Center participants, staff and community members.
- * Aggressive behavior such as physical violence of any kind, including verbal put downs, inappropriate language, bullying and disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.
- * Teens will follow directions given by Teen Center staff regarding safety, rules and activities.
- * The Sherwood YMCA has authority to terminate and/or dismiss any person in the building whose behavior is noncompliant to YMCA guidelines.

The goal for the YMCA Teen Center discipline policy is to help build responsible teens who make good choices and take responsibility for their actions and behavior.

Level 1: Arguing, swearing, refusing to listen, being inappropriate, etc.

First incident:

- Staff member(s) will have a conversation with the teen as to why choices were made. The teen will be provided with a detailed explanation as to why the behavior was not acceptable.
- Redirection from activity or situation may be needed.

Second incident:

- Staff member(s) will have a conversation with the teen as to why choices were made. The teen will be provided with a detailed explanation as to why the behavior was not acceptable.
- Redirection from activity or situation may be needed.
- Parents/guardians will be notified of the situation and informed with details and a future plan of action.

Third incident:

- Staff member(s) will have a conversation with the teen as to why choices were made. The teen will be provided with a detailed explanation as to why the behavior was not acceptable.
- Redirection from activity or situation may be needed.
- Parents/guardians will be notified of the situation and informed with details and a future plan of action.
- The teen will face possible termination from the Sherwood Teen Center

Behavior Guidelines & Disciplines (Cont.)

Level 2: Violence (i.e. hurting others, self or property), harassment, stealing or threatening staff, participants or community members

First incident:

- Staff member(s) will have a conversation with the teen as to why choices were made. The teen will be provided with a detailed explanation as to why the behavior was not acceptable.
- Parents/guardians will be notified of the situation and informed with details and a future plan of action.
- The teen will face possible termination from the Sherwood Teen Center

Free Teen Use of YMCA Facility

Active Teen Center users MAY be eligible to use the facilities in the main YMCA building.

In order to qualify, Teens must actively attend the Teen Center (at least 4 times in a month) and their eligibility is valid for the following month. Exceptions may be made according to staff discretion based on teen service, behavior, etc. This eligibility is a privilege to those active in the Teen Center and is not a Youth Membership or good towards member rates for programs.

Ex: A teen that attends the Teen Center 4 times in May can use the YMCA main building in June. In order to maintain that eligibility beyond June, the Teen will need to continue to attend the Teen Center at least 4 times per month and their name will be updated on each monthly list.

New teens will not be eligible for this usage until after their first month of attendance at the Teen Center.
